DELETE IS NEVER DELETE

There are multiple ways for others to save your Instagram pictures, posts and stories without your knowledge:

- 1) Screenshots may be taken of any and all posted photos
- 2) Recordings may be taken of your story
- 3) Certain software may be used to save stories and photos

Privacy Settings:
Make sure you are aware of your account's elected privacy settings.

Activity Visibility:
Profile > Settings > Activity Status > On/Off

Two-Factor Authentication:
Don't forget to use as an extra layer of protection.

When you create an Instagram page, the default profile setting automatically makes your account public, allowing anyone to view your posts.

Making your or your teen's Instagram profile private will ensure only approved followers see postings.

Set your posts to private in the Instagram app:

Profile > Settings > Account Privacy > Tap to toggle Private Account "on"
